

POSITION: Street Outreach Specialist, Sisters Program

REPORTS TO: Program Director

POSITION PURPOSE: As a team, provide mobile street outreach to women in the street based sex trade, including sex trafficking and survival sex.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

Scheduled Mobile Street Outreach as a Team

- Offer practical resources, information and supportive conversation to women who are or might be involved in the street based sex trade in identified North and South side areas.
- Identify ways that women are protecting their health and safety on the street and offer additional supports and resources.
- Link women to community resources including food, shelter/housing access, syringe exchange, legal rights, anti-violence advocacy, HIV/STD testing and health care; follow-up to ensure that referrals are appropriate and effective.
- Share information about the Sisters Program and the Drop-In Centers, encourage women to join the program voluntarily and connect women to Drop-in Center staff.
- As possible, provide transportation and accompaniment to appointments and urgent legal, safety and healthcare needs or connect to other staff or partners with availability.
- Make connections with local business owners, residents, criminal justice professionals and other service providers in the areas where Sisters street outreach is active.
- Implement agency and program initiatives that require involvement of Sisters staff including housing assessments, surveys and community partnerships.
- Follow all prescribed protocols for conducting outreach as documented in the outreach program manual and make decisions during outreach that are in the best interest and safety of staff, agency, and clients.

Volunteer/Intern/New Outreach Specialist Training and Support

 Support, coordinate and supervise outreach volunteers and interns, including Sisters Program participants

Evaluation and Data collection

- Track daily outreach contacts, produce monthly reports and share updates during meetings.
- Enter data into Service Point as needed.
- Identify and document outreach trends and outcomes as an outreach team, with feedback from program participants and with the Program Director on a regular basis.
- Work with Program Director to evaluate outreach program and adjust work plans as needed.

Sisters Program Support and Connection

- Participate in program staff meetings, in-service trainings and staff development opportunities.
- Meet with Program Director on a regular basis for supervision and support.

- Work with drop-in center staff as a team to coordinate client care, support drop-in center activities and the Sisters Program needs.
- Represent the Sisters Program at agency and community meetings and events as needed.
- Connect with staff from local community agencies to better link women to additional resources.
- Other duties as assigned.

Outreach Supplies and Van Maintenance

- Maintain outreach supplies and inform Program Director of both monthly needs and any potential shortages.
- Responsible for tracking and coordinating fuel and maintenance of the outreach van.
- Adhere to all policies and procedures outlined in the Benedict Center Vehicle Handbook.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- High school degree or commensurate with experience.
- Position demands a self-directed, detail-oriented, flexible person with excellent interpersonal and decision-making skills.
- Minimum 1 year of experience working in programs that serve women
- Ability to work well with women from diverse economic, racial, ethnic, gender, sexual orientation, and religious backgrounds in an open and respectful environment.
- Understanding of and commitment to harm reduction practice, trauma-informed care, self-reflection, accountability and cultural competence.
- Strong verbal and written communication skills, ability to speak effectively before groups
- Ability to mediate and resolve conflict constructively.
- Computer literacy and experience with databases and excel worksheets.
- If in recovery, must show at least one year in maintenance stage.
- Requires valid driver's license and clean driving record.
- Must be able to adapt to a flexible outreach schedule which can change depending on time and location where women are available.
- This position requires lifting up to 20 pounds as well as standing, walking, sitting and driving for extended periods of time.
- Bilingual, Spanish speaking a plus
